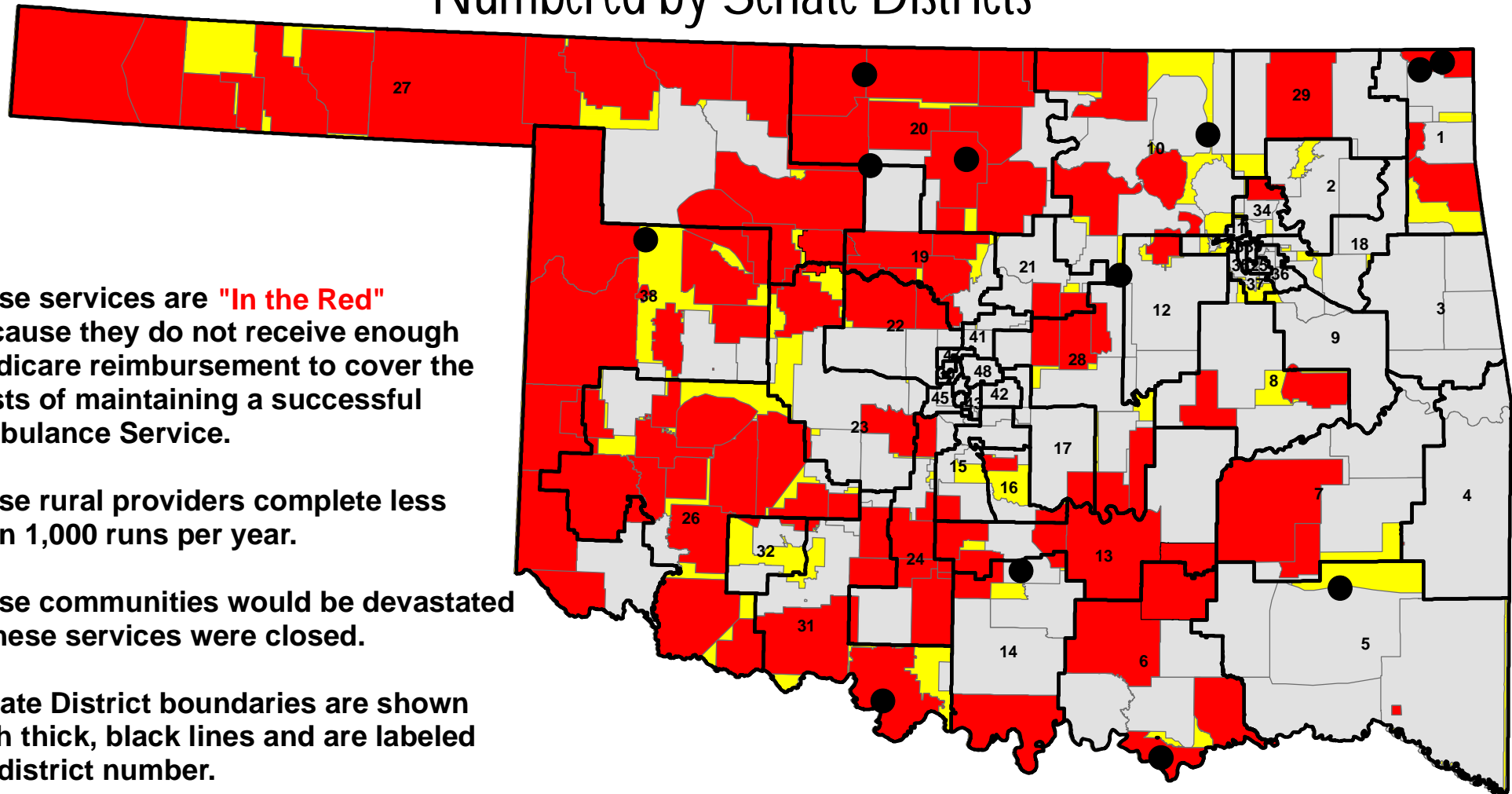


Ambulance Services in the Red Numbered by Senate Districts



- These services are **"In the Red"** because they do not receive enough Medicare reimbursement to cover the costs of maintaining a successful Ambulance Service.
- These rural providers complete less than 1,000 runs per year.
- These communities would be devastated if these services were closed.
- Senate District boundaries are shown with thick, black lines and are labeled by district number.
- Yellow areas represent regions with no primary service provider.
- The bold dots indicate locations where a local ambulance service has closed and not reopened, fraying the healthcare safety net in rural Oklahoma.
